1 VOTE-BY-MAIL

REQUEST IT Visit VotePalmBeach.gov, call (561) 656-6208, or email votemail@votepalmbeach.gov
Deadline to request a Vote-by-Mail ballot to be mailed to you is 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 1, 2022. A mail ballot can be requested in person until 5:00 p.m. on January 10, 2022.

Please have your Driver License, Florida ID card, or the last 4 digits of your Social Security number available when making your request.

RETURN IT Mail your Vote-by-Mail ballot using pre-paid postage, or drop it off inside any of our four offices during business hours. You may also drop it off at designated drop off locations across the county starting January 1, 2022. **See map for drop off times and locations.**
