Term of office:	4 years

Qualifying Period:	Noon, June 8, 2020 - Noon, June 12, 2020
Qualifying Fee:	<b>\$25.00</b> <i>(May be paid by personal funds)</i>
Method of Qualifying:	Qualifying fee <i>OR</i> Number of Petitions needed: <b>25</b>  The petition form ( <a href="#">DS-DE 104</a> ) may be downloaded from the Division of Elections website. Candidates are responsible for reproducing the petition.  Petitions must be submitted to the Supervisor of Elections office prior to Noon, May 11, 2020.
Filing Documents:	*Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository ( <a href="#">DS-DE 9</a> )  <b>AND</b> Statement of Candidate ( <a href="#">DS-DE 84</a> )  <i>*Pursuant to 99.061(3) The above forms only need to be completed by the candidate if they intend to collect and/or expend money</i>
